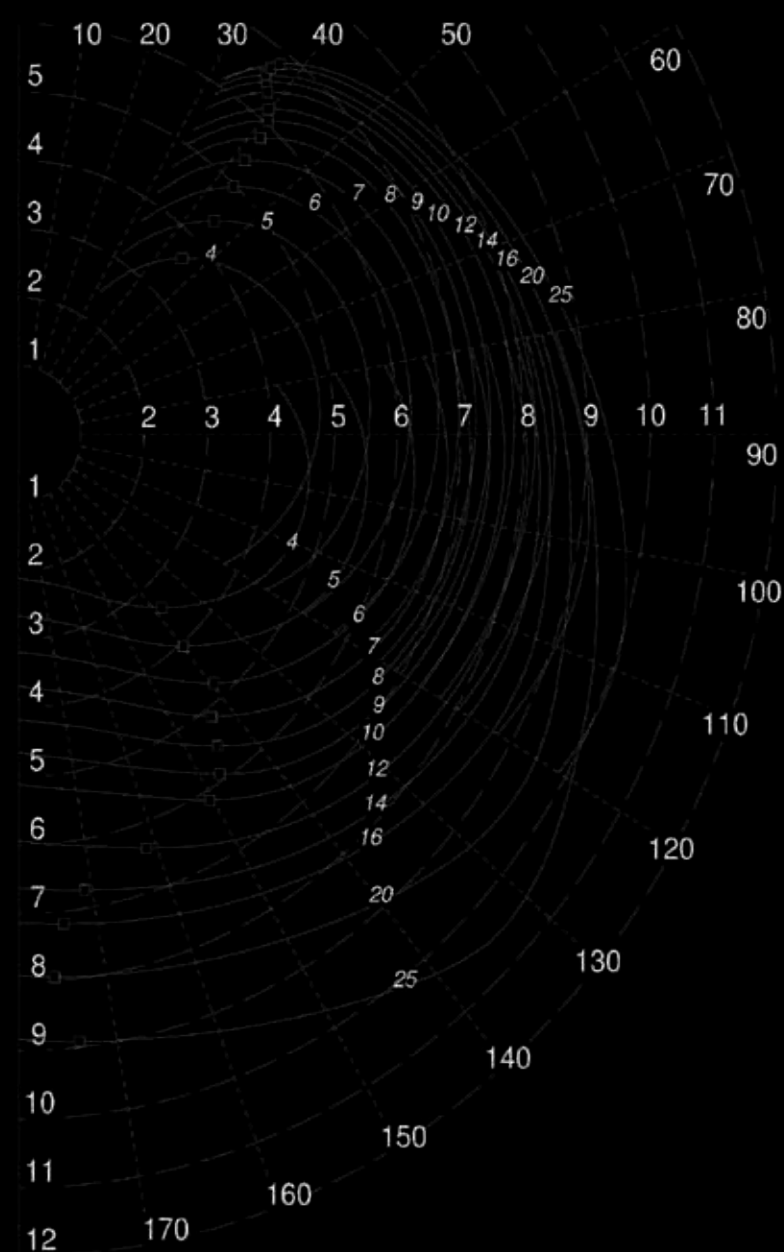

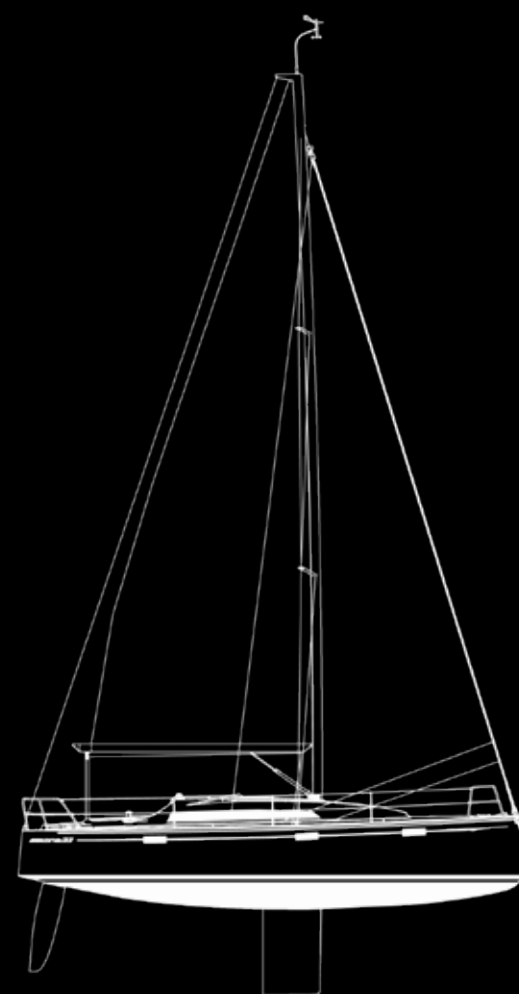


polar diagram

Salona 33 is a result of teamwork bringing together our extensive internal design and engineering resources with external designers, Olympic and professional sailors. Most importantly this new design incorporates many features recommended by Salona's cruising and racing customers. Spacious cockpit is free of obstacles, comfortable for cruising, and practical for racing. Two spacious lockers are located in the cockpit

with an additional dedicated locker for one gas bottle. Top quality sailing gear from internationally recognized suppliers make the Salona 33 easy to sail with the family, a crew, or to single hand. The S33 is offered standard with a tiller. A two steering wheel option is available making the S33 one of the smallest two wheel performance cruisers on the market.



Construction

Construction, technology and innovation have always been the strong points of the Salona yard and on S33 we have combined our experience using hi tech materials with smart design features. As on all Salona models the stainless steel frame takes the loads from the keel and shrouds and spreads them securely to

a wide area of the hull. In order to achieve maximum stiffness and durability, the construction of the new Salona 33 goes an extra step further by adding layers of carbon fibre to carefully analyzed sections of the inner hull liner. As a result, we have achieved the optimum balance between stiffness, durability and weight.

Performance

The Salona 33 will satisfy a wide range of customer demands, from safe family cruising to high level IRC or ORC racing. The S33 combines a proven and optimized hull shape, two mast options and version of cruising and performance keels with various draft options. The keel, sail and hull optimizations were developed for maximum performance combined with ease of handling.

Interior

Salona has created modern and inviting interior space by using a mix of GRP and different wood interior options, while reducing performance weight. The spacious interior is filled with daylight coming through traditional port lights, hull windows, and hatches. Standard interior is 2 cabin version which includes a spacious head, large navigation table, and functional galley.
